This Week In Kindergarten

Exciting things are going on in Kindergarten. Below you'll find the objectives that we will be working on this week. Please help us by reinforcing these objectives at home. Thank you for your help & support.

- * Math—Counting & Recognizing Numbers 0—5(KCC1)/Counting & Cardinality: making & matching sets to numbers (KCC3) / Writing numbers correctly & in order (KCC4 & 5)/Addition & Subtraction (KOA1,2) / Classify Objects & Count the number of objects in each category (KMD3)
- * Reading— Recognizing & writing our first name (RFK 1, 1d, LK1)/ Review All Letters (recognizing, writing, giving sounds/words for Each letter) (RFK 1, 2, 3) / Story Elements/ Syllables (RFK2b, c) / Multiple Meaning Words / Opposites
- * Sight Words - behind, baby, yes (recognize/write/ read)
- * Social Studies / Science— Culture (KC1,1.1,1.2) / Forces & Motion (KP1)
- * Lunch Numbers—Learn your lunch number. You have to SAY it every time we go to the cafeteria.
- * Character Trait— Good Judgement (May)
- * Homework— We will have homework Monday through Thursday nights. Please check your child's folder nightly for their homework. Along with their written homework they will need to do a reading assignment also. This year we are asking that you read to / with your child every night for 10 minutes. You will need to write down the name of the book & the author's name. Please keep this list at home. At the end of the year if your child has read 100 or more books they will receive an award. Keep this list at home. You will not need to turn it in until the END OF SCHOOL (May 1st). This is our "Wildcat 100 Reader" list.
