Mathematicians and Scientists

Math

We are really digging in deep with word problems, and taking baby steps into multi step word problems. We will also be learning how to multiply by 3 and 4 and understand how multiplication and division relate to each other through fact families and arrays.

Science

The first nine weeks focus in science we will begin a study understanding motion and the factors that affect motion, as well as understand the structure and properties of matter before and after they undergo change.

Readers and Community Experts

Reading

We will continuing to focus on fables. The skills we will work on include: main idea, context clues, parts of speech, character traits, and moral of the story. We are also diligently working on writing our own fables. The vocabulary words being practiced this week are: **central message, character traits, personification**

Social Studies

Our first nine weeks focus in Social Studies is to understand various types of communities and how events, individuals and ideas have influenced the history of local and regional communities. We will also use historical thinking skills to understand the context of events, people, and places.
